# **European Semiconductor Market in June 2002**


European Semiconductor sales in June 2002 amounted to US\$ 2.145 billion according to WSTS. This corresponds to a -14.3% decrease compared to the same month last year. Year-todate, semiconductor sales decreased by -23.9% versus the same period last year. Monthly sequential growth (i.e. June compared to May) was -4.1%.


The exchange rate of the Euro compared to the US\$ still has an impact on the growth data. Measured in Euro, semiconductor sales in June were EURO 2.318 billion, a -19.1% decline versus the same month a year ago. On a year-to-date basis, semiconductor sales decreased by -23.9% versus the same period last year. Monthly sequential growth in June was -7.7%.


On a Worldwide basis, semiconductor sales in June were US\$ 11.351 billion, a -1.6% decline versus the same period a year ago. On a monthly sequential basis, this corresponds to a growth of -0.2% and on a year-to-date basis to a decline of -14.9%.
