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European Semiconductor Market in October 2002

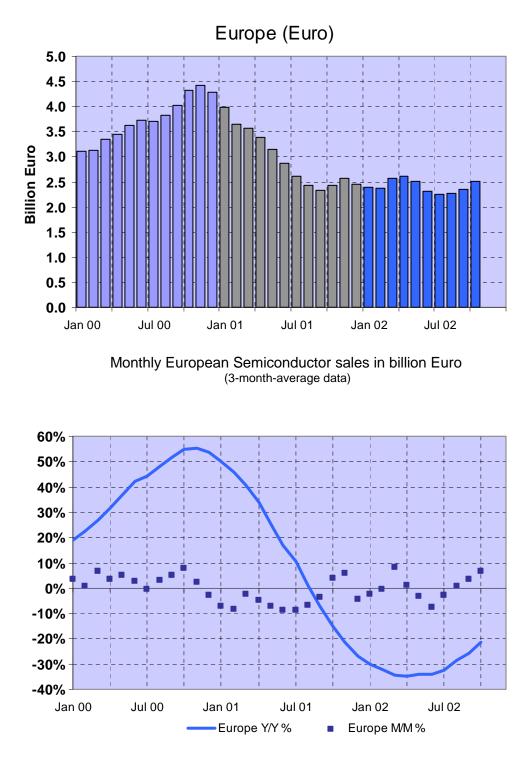
European Semiconductor sales in October 2002 amounted to US\$ 2.459 billion according to WSTS. This corresponds to a +11.7% increase compared to the same month last year. Year-to-date, semiconductor sales decreased by -12.3% versus the same period last year. Monthly sequential growth (i.e. October compared to September) was +6.2%.

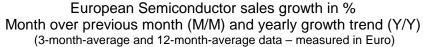
The exchange rate of the Euro compared to the US\$ has a significant impact on the growth data. Measured in Euro, semiconductor sales in October were EURO 2.506 billion, a +3.3% increase versus the same month a year ago. On a year-to-date basis, semiconductor sales decreased by -15.5% versus the same period last year. Monthly sequential growth in October was +6.6%.

On a Worldwide basis, semiconductor sales in October were US\$ 12.515 billion, a +19.9% growth versus the same month a year ago. On a monthly sequential basis, this corresponds to a growth of +1.8% and on a year-to-date basis to a decline of -2.7%.
