# Latest Semiconductor sales data, for immediate release

**Brussels, May 30, 2005** 

### No surprises in April for the European market

April data for the European market published by WSTS remain above expectation, confirming the soft landing scenario for the European industry for 2005.

Although growth rates remain on the decline, they are still on the positive side, indicating the possibility of small but positive growth at the end of the year. The related applications therefore perform similarly to the first 4 months of this year.

WSTS also reports a slight downward revision of the 1st quarter (Q1) data published last month this, however, having no impact on the overall picture of a Q1 which exceeded expectations. The revision regards the logic product categories. Consequently, in Q1 WSTS registered a total semiconductor growth of 7.3% in Europe, compared to the same quarter last year, and a 4.3% down from Q4 of last year.

European Semiconductor sales in April 2005 amounted to US\$ 3.321 billion according to the World Semiconductor Trade Statistics (WSTS), down -1.6% versus the previous month. This corresponds to a +3.0% increase compared to the same month last year. On a year-to-date basis, semiconductor sales increased by +6.7% versus the same period in 2004.

The exchange rate of the Euro compared to the US\$ still has an impact on the growth data at this time. Measured in Euro, semiconductor sales in April were EURO 2.543 billion, a decline of -1.2% versus previous month and a decline of -2.9% versus the same month a year ago. On a year-to-date basis, semiconductor sales had still a small increase by +1.0% versus the same period in 2004.

On a worldwide basis, semiconductor sales in April were US\$ 18.151 billion, down - 1.2% versus the previous month. This results in an increase of +6.8% versus the same month in 2004 and on a year-to-date basis results in a growth rate of +10.8%. (for more data please see the tables and graphs on following pages)




**EUROPE - Monthly European Semiconductor sales in billion Euro** (3-month-average data)
