# Latest Semiconductor sales data, for immediate release

Brussels, September 1st, 2005

## WSTS sales data for July published today

July's data reflect the typical patterns for the holiday season, which are more pronounced in Europe than in the rest of the world.

Product analysis suggests that the pressures of the past months on some memory products seem to be eased, with DRAM reversing the negative trend. The overall market performance shows lower sales for microcontrollers and microprocessors (together they still account for around 30% on the total chips sold this month in Europe). Lower sales are also visible for logic products, both standard and application specific categories.

European Semiconductor sales in July 2005 amounted to US\$ 3.047 billion according to the World Semiconductor Trade Statistics (WSTS), down -2.0% versus the previous month. This corresponds to a -3.7% decline compared to the same month last year. On a year-to-date basis, semiconductor sales still increased by +2.1% versus the same period in 2004.

The exchange rate of the Euro compared to the US\$ still has an impact on the growth data at this time but with a negative trend now. Measured in Euro, semiconductor sales in July were EURO 2.477 billion, flat versus previous month and a decline of -5.0% versus the same month a year ago. On a year-to-date basis, semiconductor sales show a decline of -1.7% versus the same period in 2004.

On a worldwide basis, semiconductor sales in July were US\$ 18.014 billion, up slightly 0.3% versus the previous month. This results in an increase of +0.0% versus the same month in 2004 and on a year-to-date basis it results in a growth rate of +5.8%.




# **EUROPE - Monthly European Semiconductor sales in billion Euro**
