Brussels, 3rd January 2008

European semiconductor sales up 2.0% in November

The World Semiconductor Trade Statistics (WSTS) reports a sequential increase of 2.0% of sales of semiconductors in Europe in November, compared to an increase of 0.4% in the world market.

Strong growth rates were observed for the main product categories, in particular microprocessors, microcontrollers and discretes.

DRAMs reported a strong decline in sales, when measured in dollars, although this is mainly a consequence of falling average selling prices. Sales of flash memories were almost flat in November as a result of the decrease in the NAND market, and the increase in the NOR market.

European Semiconductor sales in November 2007 amounted to 3.682 billion US dollars according to the WSTS, up 2.0% versus the previous month. This corresponds to a flat trend compared to the same month last year. On a year-to-date (YTD) basis semiconductor sales increased by 3% versus the same period in the year 2006.

The exchange rate of the Euro compared to the US dollar continues to impact the data, resulting in an almost 10% gap between growth reported in US dollars and in Euro. Measured in Euro, semiconductor sales 2007 were 2.591 billion in November, down 0.3% on the previous month and down 10.4% versus the same month a year ago. On a YTD basis semiconductor sales showed a decline of 5.4% versus the same period in the year 2006.

On a worldwide basis, semiconductor sales in November 2007 were US\$ 23.121 billion, up 0.4% versus the previous month. This results in an increase of 2.6% versus the same month in 2006 and on a YTD basis it results in a growth rate of 3.4%. (for more data please see the tables and graphs on following pages)




